The conference will include two keynote speakers:

- **Dr. Peter Dawson** (University of Calgary) is the chair of the Anthropology department and his research focuses on digital archaeology, particularly 3D scanning and 3D reconstructions of heritage sites.
- **Dr. Veldon Coburn** (University of Ottawa) is an assistant professor at the Institute of Indigenous Research and Studies, University of Ottawa, focusing on Indigenous politics, dispossession, and policy in Canada. Veldon is Anishinaabe, a member of the Algonquins of Pikwàkanagàn.
